Often, the ability to carry out state of the art research follows the ability to obtain state-of-the-art equipment. This would be aided by facilitating the transfer of information about novel technologies new to the market. To serve this goal we will evaluate proposals for scientific presentations about state-of-the-art technologies that are commercially available to Front Range Neuroscientists. We encourage you to propose a presentation from a scientific expert at your company or from a field that is relevant to your product(s) that can be considered for the Front Range Neuroscience Group Hot Stuff Workshop in December 2008.

Contest deadline: May 30. Please submit your proposal together with a letter describing the importance of the technology for the field of neuroscience by email to Stuart Tobet at stuart.Tobet@colostate.edu. This will allow time to select **ONE** presentation, and for the winner to make arrangements to attend the meeting. The choice of presentation will be totally independent of donations to set up a vendor table for the afternoon poster sessions.
